1 A RESOLUTION approving an interlocal agreement with
2 the city of Bellevue regarding the Factoria Boulevard
3 Storm Conveyance Improvements Project.

4 WHEREAS, the Factoria Boulevard storm conveyance in the City of Bellevue
5 ("Bellevue") is needed to protect infrastructure that provides regional access to businesses
6 in this commercial area, including access to T-Mobile headquarters with more than 6,000
7 employees, and

8 WHEREAS, Bellevue experiences recurrent flooding in the City's Factoria-
9 Richards Creek drainage basin during high-intensity storm events. In 2014, a heavy
10 storm event on August 12 and 13 inundated a portion of Factoria Boulevard, south of SE
11 36 Street with nearly four feet of water. Businesses were flooded, streets were
12 inaccessible, and the community was significantly disrupted. Flooding along Factoria
13 Boulevard has been reported on numerous other occasions, including October 20, 2003,
14 November 2, 2006, December 2, 2007, June 20, 2013, and May 4, 2017, and

15 WHEREAS, King County Flood Control District ("the District") has identified
16 the need for Factoria Boulevard Storm Conveyance improvements to increase storm
17 system conveyance capacity to reduce the risk of flooding along Factoria Boulevard
18 between SE 38th Street and the Richards Creek inlet channel; and

19 WHEREAS, Bellevue and the District desire to replace a segment of the existing
20 storm pipe with a larger capacity conveyance system along the north bound lanes of

21 Factoria Boulevard SE that will outfall into the Richards Creek Inlet channel adjacent to
22 the Factoria Village commercial area design to protect affected regional traffic and
23 commercial properties ("the Project"); and

24 WHEREAS, the Project is included in the District's 2021 and 2022 annual budget,
25 in a total amount of \$6,814,000 to construct the Project; and

26 WHEREAS, Bellevue has agreed to serve as the District's service provider for the
27 Project;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
29 SUPERVISORS OF THE KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT:

30 SECTION 1. The board of supervisors approves the "Agreement for Factoria
31 Boulevard Storm Conveyance Improvements Project Between the King County Flood



FCD Resolution FCD2023-02 was introduced on and passed by the King County Flood Control District on 3/14/2023, by the following vote:


