1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2022-0439, VERSION 2**

2 On page 3, after line 24, insert:

3 "C.1. Authorization to execute the interlocal agreement for jail services with
4 South Correctional Entity is conditioned on the executive limiting the number of King
5 County inmates housed at South Correctional Entity to no more than sixty per day, until
6 the executive has provided to the council an initial report on the performance of jail
7 services provided for King County by South Correctional Entity, as required by
8 subsection B. of this section and has electronically provided a letter to the clerk of the
9 council signaling the executive's intention to expand the number of King County inmates
10 housed at South Correctional Entity. The clerk shall retain an electronic copy of the letter
11 and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff and the
12 lead staff for the law, justice, health and human services committee, or its successor. The
13 letter must include:

14 a. the number of people that department of adult and juvenile justice intends to
15 house at SCORE;

16 b. confirmation of South Correctional Entity's readiness to house additional
17 King County inmates and discussion of how housing of the additional inmates would be
18 configured within South Correctional Entity; and

19 c. identification of the projected costs and funding source for housing
20 additional King County inmates at South Correctional Entity.

21 2. The council shall have thirty days from receipt of the executive's letter to
22 adopt a motion restricting the expansion of the number of King County inmates housed at
23 South Correctional Entity, after which if a motion is not adopted by the council the
24 executive is authorized to expand the number of King County inmates housed at South
25 Correctional Entity."

26 **EFFECT prepared by Leah Krekel-Zoppi: *This amendment is dependent upon***
27 ***passage of Amendment 4. It would limit the number of King County inmates at SCORE***
28 ***to no more than 60 per day until the Executive provides this first report required under***
29 ***Amendment 3 and transmits a letter stating the Executive's intention to expand the***
30 ***number of people housed at SCORE. The Council would then have 30 days to pass a***
31 ***motion prohibiting the expansion otherwise the Executive would be authorized to***
32 ***increase the number of people housed at SCORE.***
