1 A RESOLUTION recognizing June 2, 2023 as Regional
2 Community Safety and Wellbeing Day, as part of National
3 Gun Violence Awareness Day, and recognizing the work of
4 Public Health - Seattle & King County and its regional
5 partners in reducing firearm violence and injury in our
6 county.

7 WHEREAS firearm violence and injury are a multifaceted problem requiring a
8 comprehensive, interdisciplinary approach, and

9 WHEREAS, gun violence in our neighborhoods, cities, and county impacts public
10 health and public safety and deserves to be addressed through a robust public-health
11 approach that enlists multisector supports, broad investments, and lasting commitment,
12 and

13 WHEREAS, public health and law enforcement data show a continuing
14 disproportionate impact of firearm violence in south King County, in lower-income
15 neighborhoods, among young men, and in communities of color, and

16 WHEREAS, on September 21, 2017, the King County Board of Health adopted
17 Resolution 17- 09, which called on lawmakers to take meaningful action to address
18 firearm tragedies, and

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19 WHEREAS, on June 18, 2020, the King County Board of Health passed
20 Resolution 20-08 declaring racism a public health crisis and committing to work to
21 advance a public health approach in addressing institutional and systemic racism, and

22 WHEREAS, firearm violence and injury contribute to individual, family, and
23 community trauma that is part of the public health crisis of racism, and

24 WHEREAS, Public Health - Seattle & King County is working to develop and
25 implement local strategies to reduce firearm-related injury and violence, and to ensure all
26 people are healthy, hopeful, safe, and thriving, and

27 WHEREAS, a public health approach to firearm injury prevention encompasses
28 data, policy, research, prevention, and community programming and relationships, and
29 Public Health - Seattle & King County's regional approach encompasses all of these
30 solutions, and

31 WHEREAS, Public Health - Seattle & King County's Regional Gun Violence
32 Program is taking a regional approach to community safety, aligning services and
33 coordinating efforts to support and provide resources for communities impacted most by
34 violence and racial disparities in King County, and

35 WHEREAS, Public Health - Seattle & King County is working to develop and
36 implement local strategies to reduce firearm-related injury and violence, and ensure all
37 people are healthy, hopeful, safe and thriving, and

38 WHEREAS, June 2, 2023, is National Gun Violence Awareness Day, which King
39 County will observe with a series of safe storage giveaways and community events
40 intended to promote safety and wellbeing;

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41 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Health of King
42 County:

43 A. The King County Board of Health declares June 2nd, 2023, as Regional
44 Community Safety and Wellbeing Day in King County, as part of National Gun Violence
45 Awareness Day, and commits to attending and publicizing Public Health - Seattle & King
46 County's Regional Gun Violence Program events for the day.

47 B. The Board supports Public Health - Seattle & King County's Regional Gun
48 Violence Program's work and other efforts to create safe, healthy, and thriving
49 communities free of the burden of gun violence, and to support communities in healing
50 from the harm of gun violence.

51 C. The Board encourages building strong cross systems and community
52 relationships to ensure collaboration and coordination to reduce risk factors for gun
53 violence and to increase protective factors for all residents of King County.

54 D. Board members commit to raise awareness and share information about Public
55 Health - Seattle & King County public-health approach to preventing and reducing youth


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- 56 gun violence and creating conditions that allow all people to be healthy, hopeful, safe,
57 and thriving.



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

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
