Proposed No. 2022-0309.1 **Sponsors** Dembowski 1 AN ORDINANCE adopting a new concurrency test results 2 map in accordance with K.C.C. 14.70.270. 3 STATEMENT OF FACTS: 4 1. K.C.C. 14.70.270 requires the concurrency test results map to be 5 reviewed and updated in even-numbered years, or when directed by the 6 council by motion, and be submitted to council for approval by ordinance 7 no later than July 31. 2. To meet the requirement for 2022, concurrency testing has been 8 9 completed and evaluated for each travel shed. That resulted in a change to 10 one of the travel sheds requiring an update to the current concurrency test 11 results map.


