<b>1</b>	<b>Dunn</b>	Increase the project budget for the Larsen Lake Project in Bellevue. Bellevue is the service provider for the District. Entered into an ILA in 2022. If passed, ILA will need to be amended. This is a technical amendment.	\$138,500
<b>2</b>	<b>McDermott</b>	Creates a South Park Interim Flood Preparedness and Emergency Response Program: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$1,296,000 for installation and maintenance of temporary flood barriers and pumps;</li> <li>• \$225,000 for culturally appropriate public education and outreach of the flood risk in the South Park Neighborhood. Outreach work would be done by community-based organizations and trusted community leaders; and</li> <li>• \$30,000 for development of South Park specific communications materials. Materials would be available in multiple languages</li> </ul>	\$1,551,000
<b>3</b>	<b>McDermott</b>	Creates a South Park Flood Risk Reduction Project Alternatives Analysis on our 6-yr CIP. Analysis would scope, identify, and evaluate flood risk reduction alternatives in the South Park Neighborhood to address the flooding along the Duwamish River resulting from forecasted King Tide events.	\$500,000
<b>4</b>	<b>McDermott</b>	Directs King County to transmit a report to the District on the feasibility of including forecasted King Tide events in the King County Flood Warning Program. The report will be transmitted by September 15, 2024.	No increase to District budget
