## **Final network highlights**


- Increased east-west connections
  - Three new, three improved east-west routes
- Improved night service
  - 130 (43%) more trips at night (after 10pm), span increases
- More frequent service




## Route 303: Aurora Village to First Hill via Northgate and South Lake Union
