1 AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED MOTION 2011-0115, VERSION 2

2 On page 1, beginning on line 17, after "countywide" insert:

3 ",

4 WHEREAS, the historic preservation program 2011 work plan shows that the
5 program will not achieve an equal distribution of staff time between council districts in
6 2011, and

7 WHEREAS, the proviso response acknowledged that much of the work that the
8 historic preservation program performs (is reactive in nature,) depending upon being *MC*
9 approached by those interested in assistance, and

10 WHEREAS, the council seeks to ensure that the historic preservation program
11 will actively pursue a more equal distribution of resources between council districts"

12 On page 2, beginning on line 23, after "B." insert:

13 "The King County historic preservation program's 2011 work plan should be a
14 regional plan that takes affirmative steps to provide equitable distribution of program
15 resources across King County. The 2011 work plan should proactively engage in
16 activities designed to increase the amount of direct services provided to underrepresented
17 council districts. The steps should include but not be limited to actively reaching out to

18 municipalities within King County that do not have their own landmarks commission and
19 with whom the historic preservation program does not currently have an interlocal
20 agreement, in order to increase the number of interlocal agreements in council districts
21 underrepresented by historic preservation program expenditure of resources. The
22 outreach should not be limited to written correspondence and should include direct
23 contact and the development of outreach materials.

24 C. The King County historic preservation program should as part of its 2011
25 regional work plan take action to achieve greater efficiencies in its use of program
26 resources, in order to be able to devote more resources to underrepresented council
27 districts.

28 D. The King County historic preservation program should as part of its 2011
29 regional work plan actively work to increase program resources in order to be able to
30 devote more resources to underrepresented council districts. The work should include
31 diligently seeking cost recovery for services rendered to other jurisdictions.
