18	"SECTION 137. ADOPTION OF 2013 GENERAL FUND FINANCIAL PLAN.
19	The 2013 General Fund Financial Plan as set forth in Attachment I to this ordinance is
20	hereby adopted. Any recommended changes to the adopted plan shall be transmitted by
21	the executive as part of the quarterly management and budget report and shall accompany
22	any request for quarterly supplemental appropriations. Changes to the adopted plan shall
23	not be effective until approved by ordinance.
24	The General Fund Financial Plan shall also include targets for specific designated
25	reserves that shall be funded with unrestricted, unencumbered and nonappropriated funds
26	as these become available during 2013. Unrestricted, unencumbered and
27	nonappropriated funds in excess of these adopted targets and reserves shall be reflected in
28	the General Fund Financial Plan's undesignated fund balance until additional or amended
29	reserves or targets are adopted by ordinance.
30	Funds may be appropriated by ordinance from any designated reserve.
31	SECTION 138. ADOPTION OF 2013 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES
32	FUND FINANCIAL PLAN. The 2013 Emergency Medical Services Fund Financial
33	Plan as set forth in Attachment J to this ordinance is hereby adopted. Pursuant to
34	Ordinance 15862, the annual audit conducted by the county auditor of the emergency
35	medical services programs that compares actual revenues, expenditures and reserves shall
36	be based upon the financial plan adopted by the county each year during the budget
37	process. This financial plan includes indicators for: inflation; population growth; call
38	volume; labor agreements and new labor costs; fuel expenses; vehicle maintenance and
39	replacement; and the regional subsidy needed for local basic life safety program in
40	support of emergency medical services.

41	SECTION 139. ADOPTION OF 2013 BUDGET DETAIL SPENDING PLAN.		
42	The 2013 Budget Detail Spending Plan as set forth in Attachment A to this ordinance is		
43	hereby adopted pursuant to K.C.C. 4.04.040A.2.c. Any recommended changes to the		
44	spending plan shall be transmitted by the executive as part of the quarterly management		
45	and budget report and shall accompany any request for quarterly supplemental		
46	appropriations."
