1	AN ORDINANCE re	lating to solid waste fees; and
2	amending Ordinance	12564, Section 2, as amended, and
3	K.C.C. 10.12.021.	
4	STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
5	1. The solid waste division	provides essential public services that protect
6	human health and the enviro	nment and the quality of life in our region.
7	2. Ordinance 17423 was ad-	opted in September 2012, establishing new
8	fees effective January 1, 20	3, for solid waste disposal at solid waste
9	transfer stations, drop boxes	and at the Cedar Hills regional landfill.
10	3. Per tonnage costs for oth	er vehicles are intended to be the same at
11	transfer stations and at Ceda	ar Hills, necessitating a correction to the fees.
12	BE IT ORDAINED BY TH	E COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
13	SECTION 1. A. This ordin	nance proposes changes to the fees currently charged
14	for solid waste disposal at solid wa	ste transfer stations and drop boxes and at the Cedar
15	Hills regional landfill.	
16	B. These fees are establish	ned and assessed pursuant to RCW 36.58.040, RCW
17	70.93.070 and K.C.C. 10.08.040	
18	SECTION 2. Ordinance 12	2564, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.021 are
19	each hereby amended as follows:	

20	A. All persons using county-operated solid waste transfer stations and		
21	drop boxes shall pay the service fees in the following schedules:		
22	1. Solid waste disposal:		
23	Passenger cars	\$19.22 per entry	
24	Other vehicles	\$120.17 per ton	
25	Charitable organizations	\$92.55 per ton	
26	Minimum	\$19.22 per vehicle	
27	Charitable organizations, minimum charge	\$15.08 per entry	
28	2. Deposit of source-separated yard waste at yard waste collection areas, clean		
29	wood at clean wood collection areas, or any combination thereof:		
30	Passenger cars	\$12.00 per entry	
31	Other vehicles	\$75.00 per ton	
32	Minimum charge	\$12.00 per vehicle	
33	3. Deposit of white goods at white goods collection areas:		
34	White goods without regulated refrigerants	\$10.00 per unit

36	B. Service fees for the use of solid waste facilities without scales shall be based		
37	upon the cubic yard or fraction thereof as follows:

54	Disposal by other vehicles is at the discretion of the division director.		
55	D. A moderate-risk waste surcharge shall be added to all solid waste disposed by		
56	nonsolid waste collection entities using county operated solid waste facilities. The fee		
57	schedule is as follows:
