## **FCD Resolution**

	Proposed No. FCD2012-19.1 Sponsors
1	A RESOLUTION relating to the subregional opportunity fund, re-
2	allocating unexpended opportunity funds of the City of
3	Snoqualmie; and authorizing a new opportunity fund project for
4	the City of Snoqualmie.
5	WHEREAS, the King County Flood Control Zone District ("District") established
6	a subregional opportunity fund program for King County and King County jurisdictions
7	through resolution FCZD2008-10.2; and
8	WHEREAS, the City of Snoqualmie and the District have executed an "Interlocal
9	Cooperation Agreement Between the King County Flood Control Zone District and the
10	City of Snoqualmie for Opportunity Fund Projects," as authorized by Resolution FCD
11	2009-02.1 ("Interlocal Cooperation Agreement"); and
12	WHEREAS, after completing the opportunity fund projects authorized by the
13	Interlocal Cooperation Agreement, the City of Snoqualmie has an unexpended balance of
14	\$71,416 from opportunity fund distributions in the years 2008 through 2012; and
15	WHERAS, the City of Snoqualmie desires to use most of the unexpended
16	balance for a feasibility study and partial design of an engineered solution to a serious
17	erosion problem at Sandy Cove Park on the Snoqualmie River; and
18	WHERAS, the City of Snoqualmie has requested the District to approve a re-
19	allocation of \$65,350 of the unexpended balance for a new opportunity fund project,

20	called the Sandy Cove Park project, which is contained in the City of Snoqualmie's
21	approved Hazard Mitigation Plan and conforms to the subregional fund eligibility
22	criteria; now, therefore
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE KING
24	COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT:
25	SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors approves the City of Snoqualmie
26	subregional opportunity fund the Sandy Cove Park project in the amount of \$65,350. The
27	Sandy Cove Park project shall comply with requirements and procedures of the Interlocal
28	Cooperation Agreement.
29	SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the Executive Director to
30	prepare and attach to the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement an additional attachment that

32 includes the name, description and funding amount of the Sandy Cove Park Project.
