NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council will hold a public hearing in the King County Council chambers, 10th Floor, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington on Monday November 5, 2012 at 11:00 a.m. The purpose of this hearing is to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinner No. 2012-0391, which will adopt the 2013-2014 King County Capital Improvement Pragram (CIP). The CIP becomes the capital facilities component of the King County Comprehensive Plan and is adopted as a armediate to the King County Comprehensive Plan. The CIP budget for the 2013-2014 biennium is \$1.163 billion. Of that budget authority, approximately \$52.50 million is budgeted in 2013 on an annual rather than biennial basis. Of the \$1.163 billion proposed to be budgeted for 2013-2014, \$453 million is for the Wastewater Treatment capital program and \$271 million is proposed for Public Transportation bus and van pool whicle replacement.

The Capital Improvement Program Budget is divided into three program categories that reflect the goals of the King County Strategic Plan:

1 The Economic Growth and Built Environment Area proposes to expend \$530 million in the 2013-2014 biennium and encompasses economic development, transportation, planning and permitting, trails, and rural activities and services. This category supports the International Airport, road services, transit, and park facilities.

2 The Environmental Sustainability Area proposes to expend \$602 million in the 2013-2014 biennium and includes programs for safeguarding and enhancing the county's natural resources and environment. This category includes wastewater freatment, solid waste, flood and surface water, and open space acausition.

3 The General Government Area non biennial budget proposes to expend \$31 million in 2013 and reflects how the county provides services to the public. These services include lease costs for county agencies, facility maintenance and security, Horroboview Medical Center and technology improvements for King County agencies.
