1	A MOTION relating to the organization of the council; and
2	amending Motion 11122, Section D, as amended, and OR
3	2-020, Motion 11122, Section G, as amended, and OR 2-
4	040 and Motion 11122, Section H, as amended, and OR 2-
5	050.
6	WHEREAS, the council has specified by motion the chairs and vice-chairs and
7	provided for any changes to these positions to be made by adoption of a formal
8	legislative motion, and
9	WHEREAS, the council desires to specify the members of council committees,
10	committee names and functions;
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
12	I. Motion 11122, Section D, as amended, and OR 2-020 are each hereby amended
13	to read as follows:
14	In addition to any committee otherwise established by law, the committees of the
15	metropolitan King County council and their respective functions are established as
16	follows:
17	A. Budget and fiscal management committee shall consider and make
18	recommendations on: the county revenue and expenditure fiscal structural gap; capital
19	and operating budget appropriations; the sale and lease of real property to or by the

20	county; debt and investment proposals; bond issues; the office of economic and financial
21	analysis; and financial policies. The committee shall also consider the implementation of
22	appropriate labor agreements.
23	1. The committee shall develop recommendations on policy direction for the
24	2013 annual budget, based on the recommendations of other council committees and
25	taking into account the estimated fiscal impacts of state and federal legislation.
26	2. In respect to consideration of the county's proposed annual budget, all
27	members of the council not assigned to the budget and fiscal management committee
28	shall be considered ex officio voting members of the committee.
29	B. Government accountability((5)) and oversight ((and financial
30	<del>performance</del> )) committee.
31	1. The committee shall consider and make recommendations on:
32	a. improving the efficiency, cost effectiveness, and performance of all
33	branches of county government (legislative, executive and judicial)((-));
34	b. enhancing oversight, accountability, and transparency in King County
35	government, ((including financial policies,)) the office of law enforcement oversight, the
36	annual county audit program and federal, state, or county audit reports, the administration
37	of the public records act, civil rights and compliance, capital projects oversight,
38	implementation of a pre-trial risk assessment tool, strategic planning, performance
39	measurement and performance management, management organizational structure, and
40	technology management; and
41	c. general government oversight, including customer service, worker safety,
42	the department of assessments; elections; records and licensing; animal control; cable

43	communications; the county fair; King County international airport; risk management;
44	veterans, and executive services such as telecommunications, facilities management,
45	purchasing and real property management.
46	2. In the areas within the committee's purview, the committee shall track state
47	and federal legislative action and develop recommendations on policy direction for the
48	((2013)) annual budget.
49	C. Law, justice, health and human services committee.
50	1. The committee shall consider and make recommendations on policies relating
51	to:
52	a. law, safety, criminal justice and emergency management programs including
53	those related to public safety; adult detention; juvenile justice and youth services;
54	superior and district courts; judicial administration; prosecuting attorney; public defense;
55	emergency medical services; emergency management, including disaster response,
56	emergency preparedness and emergency planning;
57	b. public health programs, including those related to the protection, promotion
58	and provision functions of the department of public health, including the structure of the
59	public health centers; and
60	c. human services programs, including review of the veterans and human
61	services levy programs and options for levy renewal; therapeutic and low-income
62	housing; and civil rights and social justice. The committee shall also consider the
63	implementation of appropriate labor agreements.

64	2. In the areas within the committee's purview, the committee shall track state
65	and federal legislative action and develop recommendations on policy direction for the
66	((2012)) annual budget.
67	D. Transportation, economy and environment committee.
68	1. The committee shall consider and make recommendations on policies relating
69	to:
70	a. growth management, including land use development and regulation,
71	comprehensive planning, ((excluding the 2012-King County Comprehensive Plan,))
72	economic development, annexations and affordable housing;
73	b. the environment, including salmon recovery; resource lands; energy; surface
74	water management and water supply; wastewater treatment; solid waste; and
75	unincorporated and rural areas, including agriculture and rural services; and parks,
76	recreation and cultural resources; and
77	c. transportation, including roads and public transportation. The committee
78	shall also consider the implementation of appropriate labor agreements.
79	2. In the areas within the committee's purview, the committee shall track state
80	and federal legislative action and develop recommendations on policy direction for the
81	((2012)) annual budget.
82	((E. 2012 Comprehensive Plan review committee.
83	The committee shall consider and make recommendations on the executive's
84	proposed 2012 King County Comprehensive Plan.))
