SUMMARY This public hearing is to consider adoption of proposed ordinance relating to develop-ment regulations for recreational mari-iuana producers, processors, and retailers as authorized by the State of Washington under Initiative 502, standards for the sit-ing of recreational marijuana businesses licensed by Washington State Liauor Con-trol Board ordinance and would regulate where recreational marijuana businesses for production, processing and retail sales would be allowed. Sections 1 through 6 of the ardinance adopt

for production, processing and retail sales would be allowed. Sections 1 through 6 of the ordinance adopt new definitions or amend existing defini-tions related to the production, processing and retail sales of mariluana. Section 7 allows mariluana relail stores no larger than 5.000 square teet in the Community Business and Regional Business zones. Section 8 allows mariluana processing in several zones; in the Agriculture and Rural Area zones, only limited process-ing is allowed and only as an accessory to mariluana production. In the Community Business and Regional Business zones and in the Redmond Ridge Business Park, pro-cessing at different scales and intensity is allowed depending on whether the area is inside or outside the urban growth orea and the type of permitting process. Pro-cessing is allowed in the Industrial Zone limited to 30.000 square feet. Section 9 in the Agriculture and ny and process. In the Community Business and up to 10.000 square feet outdoors and in greenhouses. In the Community Business ond Regional Busi-ness zones and the Redmond Ridge Busi-ness process.
