7           elections in King County, to identify problems and to make recommendations, and

8           WHEREAS, those committees have consistently provided invaluable service to  
9           county voters and county government, and

10          WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453 the council established a new citizens' elections  
11          oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the committee;

12          NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

13          The appointment of Charles Gerringer to the King County citizens' elections

14 oversight committee, as the representative of an independent research and policy  
15 institution for a partial term to expire on September 18, 2015, is hereby confirmed.


