4	1.	King County has adopted K.C.C.	chapter 13.24, which requires
5	ај	pproval of comprehensive plans for	water utilities that distribute or obtain
6	w	ater in unincorporated King County	as a prerequisite for operating in
7	ui	nincorporated King County, receiving	ng approval for annexation proposals,
8	be	eing granted right-of-way franchises	and being given approval for right-
9	of	F-way construction permits. K.C.C.	13.24.060 prescribes the
10	re	quirements for approval of such pla	ns, including consistency with state
11	ar	nd local planning requirements.	
12	2.	RCW 70.116.050 requires that gen	neral comprehensive plans for public
13	W	ater supply within critical water sup	ply service areas be submitted to,
14	ar	nd approved by, the legislative author	ority within whose boundaries all or a
15	ро	ortion of a utility lies.	
16	3.	The Washington Water Service Co.	mpany Satellite System Management
17	Pl	an was last prepared in 2002. Both	Washington state Department of
18	Н	ealth and King County regulations r	equire satellite system plans to be
19	uŗ	odated every six years.	

20	4. The company proposes to provide satellite water system management
21	services within a critical water supply service area and has adopted the
22	plan.
23	5. King County has adopted a Comprehensive Plan that includes water
24	supply policies in its provisions for facilities and services (policies F-101
25	through F-254) that call for consistency with other adopted plans, support
26	for regional water supply planning, pursuit of reclaimed water, water
27	conservation and protection of water resources.
28	6. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
29	to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and
30	council on the plan and the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and
31	consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities
32	technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and company
33	operations and has found:
34	a. The plan proposes that the company provide satellite services and
35	operate countywide;
36	b. The plan is adequate to meet anticipated service needs for those
37	systems that contract with the company;
38	c. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
39	laws; and
10	d. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
11	policies.

42	7. The Washington state Department of Health approved of the company's
43	plan pending King County approval.
44	8. Under the state Environmental Policy Act, the department of natural
45	resources and parks issued a Determination of Nonsignificance for the
46	issuance of the plan on June 21, 2013, and there were no appeals.
47	9. The company's operations and facilities meet multiple existing
48	statutory, administrative, and planning standards. As the company's
49	operations, facilities, and planning meet the requirements of the King
50	County Code and are consistent with the King County Comprehensive
51	Plan, the utilities technical review committee has recommended approval
52	of the plan.
53	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
54	SECTION 1. The Washington Water Service Company Satellite System

- Management Plan, Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved as a satellite
- 56 system management plan.
