1	AN ORDINANCE relating to school impact fees; adopting
2	the Capital Facilities Plans of the Federal Way, Riverview,
3	Issaquah, Snoqualmie Valley, Lake Washington, Kent, Fife
4	and Auburn school districts as subelements of the capital
5	facilities element of the King County Comprehensive Plan
6	for purposes of implementing the school impact fee
7	program; establishing school impact fees to be collected by

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
SECTION 1. Authority. This ordinance is adopted to implement King County
Comprehensive Plan policies, Washington State Growth Management Act and King
County Ordinance 10162, with respect to the Federal Way School District, Riverview
School District, Issaquah School District, Snoqualmie Valley School District, Lake
Washington School District, Kent School District, Fife School District and Auburn
School District. This ordinance is necessary to address identified impacts of
development on the districts to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and to
implement King County's authority to impose school impact fees under RCW 82.02.050
through 82.02.080.
SECTION 2. Ordinance 10470, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 20.12.461 are
each hereby amended to read as follows:

107	B. The county's administrative costs of administering the school impact fee
108	program shall be sixty-five dollars per dwelling unit and shall be paid by the applicant to
109	the county as part of the development application fee.
110	C. The school impact fees established in subsection A of this section take effect
111	on January 1, (( <del>2005</del> )) <u>2006</u> .
112	SECTION 11. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or its application

to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
