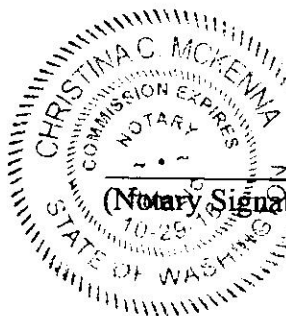

Ordinance 17839**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle Washington) on Monday, the 23rd day of June, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2013-0471 (Ordinance 17839), adopting updates to the King County Real Property Asset Management Plan (RAMP).

SUMMARY

The RAMP includes an inventory of the County's existing general government facilities and includes the conditions of the buildings owned by King County. The RAMP is a component of the capital facilities element of the Comprehensive Plan and adoption of the RAMP is part of King County's 2014 Comprehensive Plan update.

The RAMP includes all facets of asset management including planning, acquisition, disposal for land and buildings, operations and maintenance, security and disaster planning, technology, and environmental sustainability. Also included are space standards, current and future space needs, and a county facility policy framework. The ordinance aligns with the goals and objectives of the adopted King County Strategic Plan and recommends near term moves to implement space consolidation in county buildings.
