NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council will hold a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Ayenue, Seottle Washington) on Monday, the 25th day of August, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing is to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2014-0229, an ordinance establishing a demonstration project, as authorized under K.C.C. chapter 21A.55, for alluvial fan management pilat projects in areas outside of the shoreline jurisdiction.

projects in areas autside of the shoreline jurisdiction.

SUMMARY

The demonstration praject will consist of up to five individual projects located within the Snaoualmie River watershed basin, outside areas of shoreline jurisdiction, and will be implemented within streams with mean annual flows of less than twenty cubic feet per second. The individual projects will involve property awners constructing sediment management facilities designed by the Department of Natural Resources and Porks on altivuid fans with existing introstructure. "Existing intrastructure" includes such things as structures, utilities, roads, fences and pipe systems, or cleared alluvial fans used for agricultural or recreational purposes.

These pilot projects will test different designs, identify best management practices, and determine whether sediment management facilities are a viable way to address alluvial fans and the buildup of deposited materials.

The demonstration project will last for six years. A report by the Executive on lessons learned and proposed code amendments will be transmitted to the Council.
