3	STATEMENT OF	FACTS:	
4	1. King County has	s adopted K.C.C. chapter 13.24, which requires	
5	approval of compre	hensive plans for water and sewer utilities that provide	е
6	service in unincorpo	orated King County as a prerequisite for operating in	
7	unincorporated Kin	g County, receiving approval for annexation proposals	3,
8	being granted right	of way franchises, and being given approval for right	
9	of way construction	permits. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 prescribes the	
10	requirements for ap	proval of such plans, including consistency with state	
11	and local planning a	requirements.	I
12	2. The city of Tuky	vila's last comprehensive plan was approved in 2007.	
13	Washington state D	epartment of Health and King County regulations	
14	require water and se	ewer system plans to be updated every six years.	
15	3. The city owns a	water transmission line within unincorporated King	
16	County and the city	has adopted a comprehensive plan update ("the plan").
17	4. King County has	s adopted a Comprehensive Plan that includes water	
18	and wastewater poli	icies in its provisions for facilities and services	
19	(applicable portions	of policies F-201 through F-264) that call for	

20	consistency with other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water
21	conservation and protection of water resources.
22	5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
23	to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and
24	council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and
25	consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities
26	technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and city
27	operations and has found:
28	a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
29	Puget Sound Regional Council and acknowledges the housing and job
30	growth targets adopted by the Growth Management Planning Council for
31	the city's service area;
32	b. A portion of the city's water infrastructure is in unincorporated King
33	County;
34	c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
35	service needs;
36	d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
37	laws; and
38	e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
39	policies.
40	6. Washington state Department of Health approval is pending upon King
41	County's approval of the plan.

42	7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the city issued a
43	Determination of Nonsignificance for the plan on November 21, 2013.
14	There were no appeals.
45	8. The city's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
16	administrative and planning standards. As the city's operations, facilities
17	and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code and are
48	consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities
19	technical review committee has recommended approval of the plan.
50	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

51 SECTION 1. The City of Tukwila Comprehensive Water Plan, Attachment A to
52 this ordinance, is hereby approved as a comprehensive water plan.
