SUMMARY
This Proposed Ordinance would revise noise provisions to move duties of the public health administrator to the director of the department of permitting and environmental review, eliminate requirements related to agency measurement of decibel levels, clarify and expand the definition of public disturbance noises to include any noise, including from watercraft, that unreasonably disturbs or interferes with the peace, comfort or repose of persons and modify construction noise hours and decibel limits. Violation of the county noise code could result in an infraction with a fine of up to \$125 with the amount doubling with each subsequent offense within a twelve month period, but with opportunity for mediation.
