STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
1. The Washington State Con	evention Center ("WSCC") is a King County
public facilities district as aut	horized by RCW 36.100.010. In Resolution
2014-9 dated September 23, 2	2014, the WSCC has determined it is
necessary to expand the curre	nt WSCC facility to accommodate additional
and larger convention events;	that 915 Howell Street, Seattle WA ("the
subject property") is necessar	y for the WSCC expansion project; and that
despite good faith efforts to n	egotiate with the property owner, WSCC has
been unable to acquire the su	bject property. The resolution states the
WSSC's understanding that a	ll costs and expenses incurred by King
County in prosecuting the em	inent domain proceeding will be reimbursed
by WSCC as well as any amo	ounts necessary to acquire the property by

2. King County has the authority under RCW 36.100.240 to exercise its 20 power of eminent domain to acquire property on behalf of the WSCC 21 when the property to be condemned is necessary to carry out the purposes 22 of the WSCC. 23 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 24 SECTION 1. The King County council deems expansion of the Washington State 25 Convention Center to be a public use and for county purposes. Further, the King County 26 council deems it necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County for the 27 property described in Attachment A to this ordinance be condemned, appropriated, taken 28 or damaged, subject to the making or paying of just compensation to the owner of the 29 property in the manner provided by law. 30 SECTION 2. Condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to acquire 31 property and property rights as described in Attachment A to this ordinance for the 32 purpose of expanding the Washington State Convention Center. 33 SECTION 3. The attorneys for King County are hereby authorized and directed 34 to begin to prosecute the proceedings provided by law to condemn, take, damage or 35 appropriate the land and other property and property rights, including leaseholds, 36 necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, with the costs of the proceedings, 37 including litigation and acquisition expenses, legal costs, fees, interest and all other 38 associated or related costs to be paid for by the Washington State Convention Center, all 39

#### LEGAL DESCRIPTION

THAT PART OF LOT 3, BLOCK 33, SECOND ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF SEATTLE AS LAID OFF BY THE HEIRS OF SARAH A. BELL (DECEASED) (COMMONLY KNOWN AS HEIRS OF SARAH A. BELL'S 2<sup>ND</sup> ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE), ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN VOLUME 1 OF PLATS, PAGE 121, IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE MOST NORTHERLY CORNER OF SAID LOT 3;

THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG HOWELL STREET TO THE MOST WESTERLY CORNER OF SAID LOT;

THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE EAST LINE OF THE ALLEY RUNNING THROUGH SAID BLOCK, 22.03 FEET;

THENCE IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION TO A POINT ON THE EASTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT, WHICH IS 46.78 FEET SOUTH OF THE MOST NORTHERLY CORNER THEREOF:

THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID EASTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING;

EXCEPT THAT PORTION IF ANY LYING SOUTHERLY OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED LINE:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE EASTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT 32-58 FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER:

THENCE SOUTHWESTERLY TO A POINT ON THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF SAID LOT WHICH IS 20.45 FEET NORTH OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID LOT.

SITUATE IN THE CITY OF SEATTLE, COUNTY OF KING, STATE OF WASHINGTON.

### SPECIAL DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the King County Prosecuting Attorney, pursuant to RCW 36.27.020 and KCC 4.12. is the legal adviser of King County and all its branches, departments, offices, and agencies, and is primarily responsible for the commencement and defense of all lawsuits on behalf of King County; and

WHEREAS, Stephen P. VanDerhoef, of Cairncross & Hempelmann, P.S., a professional services corporation, has substantial experience and expertise in the areas of the law relevant to the matter described below; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.100.240 requires that all condemnation actions necessary for projects related to a Public Facilities District Convention Center shall be exercised through the power of eminent domain in the County that formed the Public Facility District.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Convention Center is a King County authorized and formed Public Facilities District and has identified property interests necessary for the expansion of their existing convention center.

WHEREAS, the King County Prosecuting Attorney has determined that the public interest will be best served by retaining Stephen P. VanDerhoef to represent King County regarding the condemnation action filed by King County on behalf of the Washington State Convention Center, a King County Public Facilities District;

WHEREAS, the Washington State Convention Center will be responsible for all costs of acquiring all property interests as well as for all costs and attorney's fees associated with filing and litigating this matter and that billings for said costs and fees will be submitted directly to the Washington State Convention Center for payment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the King County Prosecuting Attorney, the Washington State Convention Center, and Stephen P. VanDerhoef, do mutually agree and covenant as follows:

- 1. The King County Prosecuting Attorney hereby employs Stephen P. VanDerhoef, as a Special Deputy Prosecuting Attorney to represent the interests of King County and the Washington State Convention Center in the above-described matter, including the filing of the condemnation action, all service-related matters, and any and all subsequent litigation, including any appeals, necessary to secure the property interests identified in Ordinance \_\_\_\_\_\_, passed by the King County Council on \_\_\_\_\_.
- 2. As part of his duties, Mr. VanDerhoef shall consult with and take direction from the Washington State Convention Center or its designee, Pine Street Group L.L.C., and that from time to time will consult with Ian Taylor, Senior Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, regarding the above-described matters and issues related thereto.

- 3. Mr. VanDerhoef will bill at the hourly rate of \$405.00 per hour for services rendered plus reasonable costs associated therewith;
- 4. Mr. VanDerhoef shall serve at the pleasure of the King County Prosecuting Attorney.
- 5. King County is not responsible for any fees or costs associated with this matter. All fees, litigation related costs, and costs to acquire the property interests being condemned, including relocation benefits, shall be submitted to and paid by the Washington State Convention Center.
