1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2015-0275, VERSION 2**

2 On page 3, on line 61, after "a new Section 265" insert "and an amendment to Section
3 898"

4 On page 4, on line 70, after "ordinance and" strike "shall" and insert "should"

5 On page 4, on line 75, after "of the office" strike "shall" and insert "should"

6 On page 5, after line 93, insert:

7 **"Section 898 Department of Public Safety Employee ~~collective~~ Bargaining.**

8 The county council may enact an ordinance providing for collective bargaining by
9 the county with employees of the department of public safety. The county executive
10 shall not have veto power over this ordinance. If such an ordinance is enacted, it shall
11 designate the county sheriff as the bargaining agent of the county on all department of
12 public safety matters except for compensation and benefits, which shall be negotiated by
13 the county executive as provided in Section 890 of this charter, and civilian oversight of
14 law enforcement, which shall be negotiated by the county executive in consultation with
15 the county sheriff. Any agreement reached as a result of negotiations by the county
16 sheriff or the county executive with employees of the department of public safety shall
17 not have the force of law unless enacted by ordinance."

18 On page 5, on line 105, after "duties" strike "and" and insert ",,"

19 On page 5, on line 106, after "oversight" insert "and to make the county executive, in
20 consultation with the county sheriff, the county's bargaining agent concerning civilian
21 oversight of law enforcement"

22 **EFFECT:**

- 23 1. Adds an amendment to Section 898 of the King County Charter, making the
24 county executive, in consultation with the county sheriff, the county's
25 bargaining agent concerning civilian oversight of law enforcement.
- 26 2. Provides that the implementing ordinance "should," but is not required to,
27 give the office of law enforcement oversight the authority described in lines
28 69-78 of Proposed Substitute Ordinance 2015-0275.2; the sponsors' intent is
29 to provide additional flexibility to the Council in implementing the charter
30 amendment.

TITLE AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2015-0275, VERSION 2

On page 1, beginning on line 1, strike lines 1 through 11, and insert:

"AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on November 3, 2015, a proposition to amend Section 898 of the King County Charter and add a new Section 265 to the King County Charter, establishing a charter-based civilian office of law enforcement oversight, providing the office with appropriate authority to carry out its duties and establishing a charter-based citizen advisory committee on law enforcement oversight, making the county executive, in consultation with the county sheriff, the county's bargaining agent concerning civilian oversight of law enforcement; and appointing a committee to write the voters pamphlet statement for the November 3, 2015, special election."

EFFECT: Amends the title to conform to Amendment 1.
