8           WHEREAS, the County and the District have amended the Interlocal Agreement  
9           four times pursuant to Resolution FCD2009-04.1, Resolution FCD2010-41.2,  
10          Resolution FCD2012-15.1, and Resolution FCD2013-16.2; and

11          WHEREAS, the County and the District desire to amend the Agreement to extend  
12          its term to March 31, 2015; now, therefore,

13          BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE KING  
14          COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT:

15          SECTION 1. The board of supervisors approves the "Fifth Amendment to the  
16          Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the King County Flood Control Zone



**FIFTH AMENDMENT TO  
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
KING COUNTY AND THE KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT  
REGARDING FLOOD PROTECTION SERVICES**

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT to the "Interlocal Agreement between King County and the King County Flood Control Zone District Regarding Flood Protection Services," including all amendments thereto ("Agreement"), is entered into by KING COUNTY, a home rule charter County in the State of Washington ("County") and KING COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL ZONE DISTRICT, a quasi-municipal corporation of the State of Washington ("District"), and shall be effective upon execution by both Parties.

The Parties agree to amend Section 13.1 of the Agreement as follows:

13.1 This Agreement shall take effect January 1, 2009 and shall remain in effect through ~~December~~ March 31, 20142015.
