1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2015-0447, VERSION 2**

2 On page 22, after line 488, insert:

3 SECTION 2. Ordinance 7737, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.24.020 are
4 each hereby amended to read as follows:

5 A. The division shall maintain an updated comprehensive solid waste management
6 plan and shall review and propose plan revisions, if necessary to the council at least once
7 every five years in accordance with RCW 70.95.110, as now enacted or hereafter amended.

8 B. The county solid waste advisory committee shall review and comment upon the
9 proposed plan before its submittal to the council for adoption.

10 C. The interlocal forum shall have the following responsibilities:

11 1. Advise the county council and county executive and other jurisdictions as
12 appropriate on all policy aspects of solid waste management and planning, and consult with
13 and advise the division on technical issues;

14 2. Review and comment on alternatives and recommendations for the county
15 comprehensive solid waste management plan and facilitate approval of plan by each
16 jurisdiction;

17 3. Review proposed solid waste interlocal agreements between the county and
18 cities for planning, recycling and waste stream control;

19 4. Review disposal rate proposals;

20 5. Review status reports on: waste stream reduction, recycling, energy and
21 resource recovery; and solid waste operations with interjurisdictional impact;

22 6. Promote information exchange and interaction between waste generators, local
23 governments with collection authority, recyclers and county-planned and operated disposal
24 system;

25 7. Provide coordination opportunities between the division, local governments,
26 private operators and recyclers; and

27 8. Aid cities in recognizing municipal solid waste responsibilities, including
28 collection and recycling, and effectively carrying out those responsibilities.

29 D. The division shall seek public comment on the preliminary draft comprehensive
30 solid waste management plan, in addition to conducting the public review and comment
31 procedures required by the state Environmental Policy Act. Copies of the plan should be
32 provided to county cities, community organizations and the county council, and shall be
33 posted on the county's web site. The public comment period on the preliminary draft shall
34 be at least thirty days and shall be completed before the division transmits the preliminary
35 draft to the Washington state Department of Ecology. The division should provide
36 community organizations, commissions, cities and individuals an opportunity to submit
37 written statements. If necessary, the division should revise the preliminary draft to address
38 comments received.

39 E. The council's committee of the whole or another committee designated by the
40 council may hold hearings on the preliminary draft plan and the council shall hold a public
41 hearing on the final draft plan before adoption of the plan. Any city using county solid
42 waste facilities shall be notified of these public hearings and shall be requested to comment
43 on the plan.

44 F. The division shall submit to the council by May 1 of each year an annual report
45 of its progress toward objectives identified in the plan. That report shall also describe
46 progress in implementing the provisions of the construction and demolition ("C&D") waste
47 program as set forth in K.C.C. chapter 10.30, including, but not limited to, participation by
48 vendors who have signed designated facility agreements; the numbers of enforcement
49 actions and types of enforcement actions; effectiveness of enforcement strategy;
50 engagement with vendors on enforcement strategies, through mechanisms such as an
51 enforcement advisory group or outreach efforts; regulatory fee collection; effectiveness of
52 efforts to ensure that waste is delivered exclusively to designated facilities; volumes and
53 nature of residual C&D waste being sent to landfills for disposal; and C&D recycling rate.
54 The division must file the report in the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with
55 the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all
56 councilmembers.

57 G. Solid waste interlocal agreements between the county and cities wishing to
58 plan jointly with the county or to authorize the county to plan for them shall identify
59 which party is responsible for city solid waste operational plans, tonnage forecasts and
60 recycling goals.

61 H. The division shall provide staff support to the metropolitan solid waste
62 management advisory committee and the interjurisdictional technical staff group."
63 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any internal references
64 accordingly.

65 **EFFECT: Broadens the reporting requirements of the existing Solid Waste Annual**
66 **Report to include reporting on implementation progress for the Construction and**
67 **Demolition (C&D) Waste Program, addressing:**

- 68 • *participation by vendors who have signed Designated Facility Agreements*
- 69 • *levels and nature of enforcement activities and effectiveness of enforcement*
70 *strategy*
- 71 • *outreach to vendors on enforcement strategies*
- 72 • *revenue generation and utilization*
- 73 • *effectiveness of efforts to direct waste stream exclusively to participating*
74 *designated facilities*
- 75 • *volumes and nature of residual C&D waste being sent to landfill disposal*
- 76 • *C&D waste recycling rate.*

8 10.04.020, Ordinance 7737, Section 2, as amended and
9 K.C.C. 10.24.020, Ordinance 10916, Section 1, as
10 amended, and K.C.C. 10.30.010, Ordinance 10916, Section
11 4, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.30.020, Ordinance 10916,
12 Section 7, as amended, and K.C.C. 10.30.050 and
13 Ordinance 17527, Section 158, and K.C.C. 4A.200.700 and
14 adding a new section to K.C.C. chapter 4A.670."
