1		AN ORDINANCE approving	the Lakehaven Utility
2		District Water System Plan Up	odate.
3		STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
4		1. King County has adopted K.C.C. c	hapter 13.24, which requires
5		approval of comprehensive plans for v	water and sewer utilities that provide
6		service in unincorporated King Count	y as a prerequisite for operating in
7		unincorporated King County, receivin	g approval for annexation proposals,
8		being granted right of way franchises,	and being given approval for right
9		of way construction permits. K.C.C.	chapter 13.24 prescribes the
10		requirements for approval of such plan	ns, including consistency with state
11		and local planning requirements.	
12		2. The Lakehaven utility district's last	t general water facility plan was
13		prepared in 2008. Washington state D	Department of Health and King
14		County regulations require water syste	em plans to be updated every six
15		years.	
16		3. The Lakehaven utility district has a	a service area within King County
17		and has adopted a water system plan u	update ("the plan").
18		4. King County has adopted a Compr	ehensive Plan that includes policies
19		F-101 through F-254, the applicable p	ortions of which address water

20	policies for facilities and services; these water policies call for consistency
21	with other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water conservation
22	and protection of water resources.
23	5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee
24	to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and
25	council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and
26	consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities
27	technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and system
28	operations and has found:
29	a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the
30	Puget Sound Regional Council;
31	b. The district's service area includes portions of unincorporated King
32	County;
33	c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and
34	service needs;
35	d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality
36	laws; and
37	e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and
38	policies.
39	6. Washington state Department of Health approval is pending upon King
40	County's approval of the plan.
41	7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act the district completed an
42	environmental check list and the district issued a Determination of

43	Nonsignificance for the plan approval on September 25, 2014. There were
44	no appeals.
45	8. The district's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,
46	administrative and planning standards. As the district's operations,
47	facilities and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code
48	and are consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities
49	technical review committee has recommended approval of the plan.
50	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

51 SECTION 1. The Lakehaven Utility District Water System Plan Update,

52 Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved as a comprehensive water plan.
