**KING COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH  
NOTICE OF RULEMAKING - BOH 15-03  
A Regulation on the Adoption of Revised  
Water Source Requirements for  
On-site Sewage Systems**

Pursuant to its authority under RCW 70.05.060, the King County Board of Health hereby gives notice of proposed rulemaking to adopt recent amendments, by the State of Washington Department of Health, to the state water supply regulations governing water quality standards.

The purpose of the proposed rulemaking is to update the King County Board of Health On-site Sewage Regulations by adopting the recently revised state drinking water standards in Chapter 246-291 WAC governing the analytical testing of well water for coliform bacteria and inorganic contaminants, including nitrate and arsenic. The proposed rule updates the Board of Health well water source requirements to conform to the revised state standards.

The proposed rule also updates the citation to the Uniform Plumbing Code adopted by the State Building Code Council under Chapter 51.56 WAC. The revision conforms the Board of Health On-site Sewage Regulations to the current state standards governing the design of rain-water catchment systems as water supply sources.

A public hearing on the proposed rule at which the public may state their views orally or in writing will be held during the regular meeting of the King County Board of Health, October 15, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. in the Metropolitan King County Council Chambers, 10th floor, Courthouse, 516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA. Written comments can also be submitted to: King County Board of Health, ATTN: Maria Wood, Public Health - Seattle & King County, 401 Fifth Avenue, Suite 1300, Seattle, WA 98104; [maria.wood@kingcounty.gov](mailto:maria.wood@kingcounty.gov).
