1 **AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED MOTION 2016-0105, VERSION 1**

2 On page 2, beginning on line 25, insert:

3 "C. King County Medic One emergency medical services, within sixty days of the
4 effective date of this motion, shall file a report in the form of a paper original and an
5 electronic copy with the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an
6 electronic copy to all councilmembers. The report shall include at a minimum the
7 following information:

- 8 1. Program name, if other than that stated in subsection B;
- 9 2. Program guidelines and procedures, including;
 - 10 a. Process for identifying and selecting the individuals authorized to
 - 11 evaluate nominations and select program recipients;
 - 12 b. Process for submitting nominations;
 - 13 c. Criteria for evaluating and selecting individuals for program
 - 14 recognition;
 - 15 d. Plan for recognition of selected recipient.

16 D. Upon program recipient selection, King County Medic One emergency
17 medical services shall notify the councilmember in which the selected recipient resides,

18 as well as provide details regarding the date, time and manner of program recognition as
19 this information becomes available.”

20 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any internal
21 references accordingly.

22 ***EFFECT: Requires King County Medic One Emergency Medical Services to provide to***
23 ***Council information regarding processes and criteria for establishing and managing a***
24 ***King County Medic One/EMS Citizen Hero Recognition Program. Also requires***
25 ***councilmember notification when a constituent is selected for program recognition.***
