26	PROVIDED FURTHER THAT
27	For Project 395716, titled Courthouse South Addition, the appropriated amount
28	includes funding for consulting services for independent project monitoring. The scope
29	of work for the independent project monitoring will include at a minimum:
30	1. Project monitoring of compliance with generally accepted project managemen
31	practices. Intent of such review is to provide reasonable assurance to the County that
32	financial responsibilities and compliance with generally accepted project management
33	practices are achieved throughout the project.
34	2. Monitoring of compliance with adopted scope, schedule and budget during
35	construction phases.
36	3. Monitoring during all phases to assess the adequacy and accuracy of
37	management reports.
38	4. Confirmation of the construction progress and evaluation of the contractor's
39	monthly payment requests.
