1 AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste division site  
2 disposal fees; making technical corrections; and amending  
3 Ordinance 12564, Section 2, as amended, and  
4 K.C.C.10.12.021.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Section 2 of this ordinance proposes changes in the fees  
9 currently charged for use of disposal sites.

10

B. These fees are assessed pursuant to K.C.C. 2.99.030.

11

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12564, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C.10.12.021 are  
12 each hereby amended to read as follows:

13

**Fees for use of disposal sites.** All persons using county-operated solid waste  
14 disposal facilities shall pay the service fees in the following schedules:

15

A. Service fees for the use of disposal sites with scales, excluding Cedar Hills,  
16 shall be:

1. Solid waste disposal:

18	Passenger cars	\$((13.72)) <u>13.62</u> per entry
19	Other vehicles	\$82.50 per ton
20	Charitable organizations	\$63.50 per ton
21	Minimum	\$((13.72)) <u>13.62</u> per vehicle
22	Charitable organizations, minimum charge	\$((10.58)) <u>10.48</u> per entry

23           2. Deposit of source-separated yard debris at yard debris collection areas and  
24 deposit of clean wood at clean wood collection areas:

25	Passenger cars	\$12.75 per entry
26	Other vehicles	\$75.00 per ton
27	Minimum charge	\$12.75 per vehicle

28           3. Deposit of white goods at white goods collection areas:

29	White goods without regulated refrigerants	\$10.00 per unit
30	White goods with regulated refrigerants	\$24.00 per unit

31           B. Service fees for the use of disposal sites without scales, such as mobile yard  
32 debris facilities, shall be based upon the cubic yard or fraction thereof as follows:

33           1. Solid waste disposal:

34	Passenger cars	\$((13.72)) <u>13.62</u> per entry
35	Other vehicles	
36	Compacted wastes	\$23.86 per cubic yard
37	Uncompacted wastes	\$13.72 per cubic yard
38	Minimum charge	\$((13.72)) <u>13.62</u> per vehicle

39           2. Deposit of source separated yard debris at yard debris collection areas:

40	Passenger cars	\$12.75 per entry

42	Compacted wastes	\$21.50 per cubic yard
43	Uncompacted wastes	\$12.75 per cubic yard
44	Minimum charge	\$12.75 per vehicle
45	C. Service fees at the Cedar Hills landfill shall be:	
46	Cedar Hills Regional Direct	\$69.50 per ton
47	Other vehicles	\$82.50 per ton
48	Disposal by other vehicles is at the discretion of the solid waste manager.	
49	D. A moderate-risk waste surcharge shall be added to all solid waste disposed by	
50	nonsolid waste collection entities using county operated disposal facilities. The fee	
51	schedule is as follows:	
52	1. For sites with scales:	
53	Self-haulers	\$ <del>((2.61))</del> <u>3.50</u> per ton
54	Minimum charge	\$ <del>((1.00))</del> <u>1.34</u> per entry
55	Passenger cars	\$ <del>((1.00))</del> <u>1.34</u> per entry
56	2. For sites without scales:	
57	Compacted	\$ <del>((0.76))</del> <u>0.77</u> per cubic yard
58	Uncompacted	\$0.44 per cubic yard
59	Minimum charge	\$ <del>((1.00))</del> <u>1.34</u> per entry
60	Passenger cars	\$ <del>((1.00))</del> <u>1.34</u> per entry
61	E. A special waste fee shall be charged for special waste including infectious	
62	waste treated and handled in accordance with King County Board of Health Code	
63	10.28.070, asbestos-containing waste material, problem wastes and other additional	

64 wastes requiring clearances in accordance with King County Board of Health Code Title  
65 10 or rules promulgated by the department.

66	Special waste fee	\$132.00
67	Minimum charge	\$22.20

68 F. In the absence of exact weights or measurements, the estimate of the manager  
69 is binding upon the user.

70 G. Solid waste either generated or collected, or both, within the boundaries of a  
71 jurisdiction that has not entered into an agreement with King County for use of King  
72 County solid waste disposal facilities as provided by this chapter may only be disposed of  
73 in a King County facility upon payment of a special service fee of three times the  
74 applicable per ton rate for facilities with scales and three times the applicable cubic yard  
75 rate for compacted and uncompacted wastes for facilities without scales. Payment of the  
76 special service fee (~~(in)~~) under this subsection shall be in lieu of payment of the fees in  
77 subsections A<sub>2</sub> through E<sub>2</sub> of this section. Nothing in this subsection authorizes the use of  
78 King County facilities by any municipal corporation or agent thereof or any commercial  
79 hauler for disposal of solid waste (~~(either)~~) either or both generated and collected  
80 outside King County.

81 SECTION 3. At least thirty days prior to the effective date of section 2 of this  
82 ordinance, the solid waste division shall provide notice of the fee revisions provided for  
83 in section 2 of this ordinance, by posting or distributing revised fee information at the  
84 county transfer stations, and by posting revised fee information on the web page of the

85 solid waste division.


86 SECTION 4. Section 2 of this ordinance takes effect January 1, 2006.

Ordinance 15318 was introduced on 10/24/2005 and passed as amended by the Metropolitan King County Council on 11/14/2005, by the following vote:




