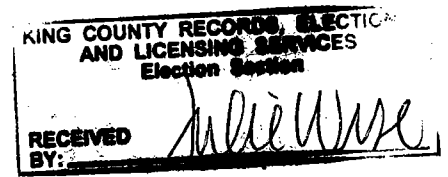

11 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for
12 annual general elections held in King County, and

13 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction
14 that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction
15 shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the
16 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,

19 unincorporated area known as Greenwood Point-South Cove, on November 8, 2005, on




