Temple was selected to represent King County with state government officials; 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 16 The chair of the metropolitan King County council is authorized to enter into a 17 contract, in accord with the request for proposals and scope of services attached to this

Legislature and the state executive branch on all issues of concern to King County, and to

be an advocate on the county's behalf on all issues, including, but not limited to, growth

management, water and sewer and threatened and endangered species, for a one-year
