## Ordinance/Motion: 2016 Omnibus

Title: Basic Food Education and Training Program Expenditures
Requesting Agency: EMPLOYMENT EDUCATION RESOURCE (EN_A93600)

DCHS began administering the Basic Food Education and Training Program (BFET) in 2014. The actual BFET program has ended up being about $\$ 530,000$ larger in $2015-16$, in terms of both revenue and expenditures, than was assumed in the adopted budget due to increased funding from the state, which administers the program. This decision package requests revenue-backed appropriation authority for program spending in the amount of $\$ 435,000$. The remaining expenditure authority is requested to support an FTE in decision package S3_004 in EN_A93600.
