| 16 |      | 3. The city has a service area within F | King County, is a component agency     |  |
| 17 |      | of the regional wastewater system and   | has adopted a comprehensive sewer      |  |
| 18 |      | plan update ("the plan").               |  |  |

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| 19 | 4. King County has adopted a Comprehensive Plan that includes policies       |
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| 20 | F-101 through F-264, the applicable portions of which address wastewater     |
| 21 | policies for facilities and services; the policies call for consistency with |
| 22 | other adopted plans, pursuit of reclaimed water, water conservation and      |
| 23 | protection of water resources.   |
| 24 | 5. K.C.C. chapter 13.24 requires the utilities technical review committee    |
| 25 | to review and make a recommendation to the King County executive and         |
| 26 | council on the plan, the requirements under K.C.C. chapter 13.24 and         |
| 27 | consistency with the King County Comprehensive Plan. The utilities           |
| 28 | technical review committee has reviewed the planning data and system         |
| 29 | operations and has found:  |
| 30 | a. The plan uses population and employment forecasts developed by the        |
| 31 | Puget Sound Regional Council;  |
| 32 | b. The city's service area includes portions of unincorporated King          |
| 33 | County;  |
| 34 | c. The capital facility plan is adequate to meet anticipated facility and    |
| 35 | service needs;   |
| 36 | d. The plan is consistent with applicable Washington state water quality     |
| 37 | laws; and  |
| 38 | e. The plan is consistent with other pertinent county adopted plans and      |
| 39 | policies.  |
| 40 | 6. Washington state Department of Ecology approval is pending upon           |
| 41 | King County's approval of the plan.  |

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| 42 | 7. Under the state Environmental Policy Act, the city issued a              |
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| 43 | determination of nonsignificance for the issuance of the plan on May 6,     |
| 44 | 2015. There were no appeals.  |
| 45 | 8. The city's operations and facilities meet multiple existing statutory,   |
| 46 | administrative and planning standards. As the city's operations, facilities |
| 47 | and planning meet the requirements of the King County Code and are          |
| 48 | consistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, the utilities           |
| 49 | technical review committee has recommended approval of the plan.            |
| 50 | BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:                               |
| 51 | SECTION 1. The City of Auburn 2016 Comprehensive Sewer Plan (General        |

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- 52 Sewer Plan), Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby approved as a comprehensive
- 53 sewer plan.
