7		STATEMENT OF FACTS:	
8		1. K.C.C.4A.700.610 authorizes Metro transit to provide free or	
9		discounted fare media for the purpose of attracting new ridership),
10		relieving congestion, developing market strategies, testing prices	or
11		experimental service and implementing other special transit prog	rams or
12		promotions.	
13		2. The annual loss in revenue from such programs and promotio	ns is
14		limited to \$350,000.	
15		3. There is increasing interest in temporarily waiving or discoun	ting fares
16		to test new strategies for improving access to transit and to the cu	ıstomer
17		benefits of ORCA fare payment for youth, college students and s	enior and
18		disabled riders.	
19		BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:	

20 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this ordinance takes effect January 1, 2017. 21 SECTION 2. Ordinance 12643, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C 4A.700.610 are each hereby amended to read as follows: 22 23 For the purpose of attracting new ridership, relieving congestion, developing market strategies, testing prices or experimental service, and implementing other special 24 transit programs or promotions, the director may waive or discount the fare or pass prices 25 otherwise established in this chapter whenever the waiver or discount is not expected to 26 27 require the addition of regularly scheduled public transportation services and, in the judgment of the director, the value of the program or promotion and the benefit to the 28 public exceeds the expected loss of revenue. The loss in revenue of all such programs, 29 30 promotions and fare discounts shall, in the aggregate, be no greater than ((three)) five 31 hundred fifty thousand dollars annually. 32 SECTION 3. Section 4 of this ordinance takes effect January 1, 2019. 33 SECTION 4. Ordinance 12643, Section 18, as amended, and K.C.C 4A,700,610 34 are each hereby amended to read as follows: 35 For the purpose of attracting new ridership, relieving congestion, developing market strategies, testing prices or experimental service, and implementing other special 36 transit programs or promotions, the director may waive or discount the fare or pass prices 37 38 otherwise established in this chapter whenever the waiver or discount is not expected to 39 require the addition of regularly scheduled public transportation services and, in the judgment of the director, the value of the program or promotion and the benefit to the 40 public exceeds the expected loss of revenue. The loss in revenue of all such programs, 41

- promotions and fare discounts shall, in the aggregate, be no greater than ((five)) three
- 43 hundred fifty thousand dollars annually.
