

Facility Master Plan


What is it: A plan identifying the operational facility needs between now and

future to other capital investments



Major Projects for 2019/20

- Grow Operational Capacity
 - Use space at existing bases for core functions
 - Strategic expansion (buy land) at existing bases
 - Find interim capacity to ease current pinch points
 - Build an 8th base by 2025
 - Build a 9th base by 2030
