The notice shall provide that members of the public may submit comments on the proposed honorary name designation to the clerk of the council no later than August 31, 2018, and shall include both email and regular postal mail addresses to which comments may be submitted. The clerk of the council shall retain any submitted comments and provide, by September 10, 2018, copies of submitted comments to all councilmembers, the council chief of staff, the policy staff director and the lead staff for the mobility committee.
