NOTICE OF RULEMAKING – BOH 18-03

A Regulation to Revise the Local
Hazardous Waste Management Fees

Pursuant to its authority under RCW 70.05.060 and 70.105.220, the King County Board of Health hereby gives notice of proposed rulemaking to adopt revisions to the local hazardous waste management fees paid by solid waste collection service ratepayers, sewage treatment plant operators, transfer stations and landfills for services to reduce exposure to toxic materials by King County's growing and increasingly diverse population. The purpose of the proposed rulemaking is to increase the annual rates by 3.5 percent for 2019, and an additional 3.5 percent for 2020 and beyond, to meet inflation-related cost increases and maintain services at current levels. The rates proposed for 2020 will remain unchanged for each subsequent year unless revised again by the Board of Health.

A public hearing on the proposed rule at which the public may state their views orally or in writing will be held during the regular meeting of the King County Board of Health, June 21, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. in the Metropolitan King County Council Chambers, 10th floor, Courthouse, 516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA. Written comments can also be submitted to: King County Board of Health, ATTN: Serena Galaviz, Public Health – Seattle & King County, 401 Fifth Avenue, Suite 1300, Seattle, WA 98104; serena.galaviz@kingcounty.gov. Written comments mailed or delivered to this address must be received by 5 p.m. on the day preceding the Board of Health meeting.
