# **Description of request:**

This ordinance authorizes the County to enter into two agreements with the Washington State Major League Baseball Public Facilities District (PFD). One agreement would allocate a portion of the County's lodging tax to the PFD to support major maintenance projects at the publicly-owned Safeco Field. The other agreement would create a mechanism for the County to issue bonds at the PFD's request for such projects, with the debt service to be paid from the lodging tax allocated to the PFD.
