Proposed Ordinance 2018-0311

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2018, at 1:30 p.m., to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2018-0311.

Proposed Ordinance 2018-0311:

• Sets the 2019-2020 Solid Waste Division disposal fees.

• The basic fee is set at \$140.82 per ton. This fee is charged to per-ton-rate vehicles disposing of municipal solid waste at King County solid waste transfer stations and drop boxes.

• The transfer station entry fee for fixed-rate vehicles is set at \$22.53 per entry.

• The regional direct fee is set at \$120.00 per ton. This fee is charged to commercial collection companies that haul solid waste to the Cedar Hill landfill from their own transfer stations and processing facilities, bypassing County transfer stations.

• Fees for charitable organizations, special wastes, special wastes requiring extra handling, and use of facilities without scales are also adjusted.

• Defines the vehicle classes of "fixed-rate vehicles" and "per-ton-rate vehicles"

• Establishes a low-income discount program for qualified, low-income, non-account customers. Qualified customers under the program must be at or below two-hundred percent of the federal poverty level as defined by the U.S. Health and Human Services Department.

In addition to current version of the proposed legislation, Councilmembers may offer amendments for the Council's consideration. As a result, persons interested in any of the issues raised in the proposed legislation should make their views known at the public hearing on September 10, 2018.
