### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

#### Ordinance 18866

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on March 13, 2019 at 10:30 a.m. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public testimony relating to Ordinance 18866, which adopted findings in support of and adopted for six months a moratorium prohibiting the establishment of new or expansion of existing major fossil fuel facilities, and requiring a study to address the issues and circumstances necessitating the moratorium.

#### Background

Ordinance 18866 was adopted on January 28, 2019. A public hearing within sixty days of the enactment of a moratorium and the adoption of findings is required by RCW 90.58.590 and RCW 36.70A.390. This hearing is opportunity for public testimony on the moratorium.
