The only recommended change to the latest document (attached) is:

Currently the Existing Proposal indicates \$10M in funding has been added to line 37-40 (Regional and Other Public Trail Systems) This is supported. The funding for the increase was via a decrease of 10M in the Towns and Cities Open Space Acquisition/Land Conservation. (line 21) I would recommend that the 10M funding increase be via a 5M decrease in line 21 (cities and towns) and a 5M decrease in line 20 (King County Open Space. By doing this the added Regional trail projects would be funded by a balance of local cites and King County.
