NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a proposed ordinance for the vacation of portions of NE 32nd Street – Solomon Korkela Extension County Road, Road No. 1334 has been filed with the Clerk of the County Council.

A public hearing will be held before the King County Hearing Examiner, on the **Twelfth Floor – in the Horiuchi Conference Room**, of the King County Courthouse, 516 – 3rd Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104 on **Tuesday April 30, 2019** at 1:00 pm or soon thereafter.

NOTE: If the Seattle School District announces a district-wide school closure due to adverse weather conditions or similar area emergency, the public hearing on this matter will be postponed. Parties of record will be notified of the time and date of the rescheduled hearing. Questions can be directed to the Hearing Examiner's Office at (206) 477-0860.

The area to be vacated is described as follows:

That portion of NE 32nd Street lying within the northwest quarter of Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 7 East, W.M. The general location of the Street begins at the east line of the PSE (formerly Puget Sound Power and Light) right of way on the east side of the old Milwaukee Railroad right of way and extends easterly to the terminus of the Street. It is more particularly described as follows: All that portion of NE 32nd Street (also known as Solomon Korkela (Bunker) Road #1334) lying east of the west line of the northwest quarter of Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 7 East, W.M., and west of the following described line: Beginning at a point S89°11'E 1321.2 feet to the west quarter of said Section 22; Thence S89°16'30"E 500 feet; Thence N01°20'30"W 961.90 feet to a point on the north right of way margin of said Solomon Korkela County Road #1334 and the terminus of this line. The east line of this vacation is the west line of that portion of this road vacated December 10, 1973 by King County Ordinance No. 1862. Situate in the County of King and State of Washington. Containing approximately 105,890 square feet, more or less. The adjacent parcels are zoned RA10 and A 10.
