NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a proposed ordinance for the vacation of portions of SE 184th Street has been filed with the Clerk of the County Council.

A public hearing will be held before the King County Hearing Examiner on the **Twelfth Floor – in the Fred Conference Room**, of the King County Courthouse, 516 – 3rd Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104 on Tuesday August 27, 2019 at 9:30 am or soon thereafter. This hearing is a continuation of the hearing began February 27, 2018.

NOTE: If the Seattle School District announces a district-wide school closure due to adverse weather conditions or similar area emergency, the public hearing on this matter will be postponed. All those portions of a 30 foot wide right of way for SE 184th Street lying within the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 36, Township 23 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian abutting Lots 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13, Block 2 of the Plat of Lake Desire Summer Home Tracts according to the plat recorded in Volume 39 of Plats at page 44, Records of King County, Washington. Situate in the County of King and State of Washington.

Containing an area of 20,622 square feet, more or less. The adjacent parcels are zoned R6.
