Recommendations for expenditures for projects and programs, including those identified in Motion 15378, over the life of the levy reflecting a three-percent reduction in total anticipated collections. The expenditure recommendations shall prioritize fully funding projects identified in Attachment C to Motion 15378 that have external partners as the lead agency, including cities, towns, and school districts. The expenditure recommendations shall also include providing levy proceeds to the Seattle Aquarium in the amount of \$8,000,000 in the first four years of the levy.

The executive should file the report and a motion required by this proviso by June 30, 2020, in the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all
