NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 4th day of December, 2019, at 9:30 a.m., to consider a system of rates and charges proposed by the King Conservation District (KCD) for the year 2020 ("the KCD proposal") in conjunction with the public hearing on Proposed Ordinance 2019-0424, which would adopt a system of rates and charges for the KCD and its duration.

SUMMARY

The KCD proposal requests that the Metropolitan King County Council consider and approve a natural resource conservation system of rates and charges for the King Conservation District for 2020 in the following amounts: agricultural lands, \$13.57 per parcel per year; residential lands, \$13.04 per parcel per year; institutional or public lands \$13.25 per parcel per year; commercial lands, \$12.90 per parcel per year; open space lands, \$12.69 per parcel per year; vacant or undeveloped lands, \$12.67 per parcel per year; and forested lands, \$0 per parcel per year; with the following lands exempted from such charges: lands owned by federally recognized Native American tribes or members of such tribes that are located within the historical boundaries of a reservation.

The KCD proposal provides that the use of revenues from the system of rates and charges would be to implement a proposed program of work and budget.
