Amendments to 2007 Budget

Goal: Review and make recommendations to the full Council on all proposed ordinances amending the 2007 budget ordinance.

Key Work Program Items:

- Review up to four quarterly omnibus budget supplemental ordinances;
- Review "stand-alone" capital budget supplemental requests;
- Track and report on capital budget provisos and responses;
- Review base budgets for biennial budget pilot.

Financial Analysis and Project Monitoring

Goal: Review financial reports, project reports, financial plans and other documents in order to track budget ordinance and policy compliance, financial status of long range projects, and other capital financial issues.

Key Work Program Items:

- Review quarterly management and budget reports from Office of Management and Budget;
- Review other reports and documents in order to track financial condition of major projects;
- Support the Financial Policies Advisory Task Force.

Capital Project Oversight Pilot Project

Goal: Work closely with the County Auditor who is conducting oversight and performance for four major projects.

Key Work Program Items:

- Support the Auditor in their work and planning; provide input and direction for development of the Capital Project Oversight Office
- Review projects through regular briefings and updates;
- Continue review of current oversight contracts.

Capital Project Budgets and Policy Direction

Goal: Review and make recommendations to the full Council on all proposed substantive "stand alone" capital requests, as well as major policy updates.

Key Work Program Items:

- Review of the 2006 Space Plan;
- Review of proposed surplus properties;
- Sale of county owned land;
- Review work plans for future use of capital facilities.
