METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF HEARING 2019-0424

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the Metropolitan King County Council, Room 1001, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, on the 4th day of December, 2019, at 9:30 a.m., to consider Proposed Ordinance 2019-0424, which would adopt a system of rates and charges for the King Conservation District (KCD) for the years 2020-2024.

SUMMARY

Proposed Ordinance 2019-0424 authorizes the King County executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with the King Conservation District and imposes natural resource conservation rates and charges for the King Conservation District effective January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2024, on each parcel of real property within the King Conservation District. The proposed rates and charges in 2020 are as follows: agricultural lands, \$12.00 per parcel per year; residential lands, \$11.63 per parcel per year; institutional or public lands, \$11.72 per parcel per year; commercial lands, \$11.47 per parcel per year; open space lands, \$11.40 per parcel per year; vacant or undeveloped lands, \$11.39 per parcel per year; and forested lands, \$0 per parcel per year. The proposed rates and charges would reflect inflationary adjustments in subsequent years: 2.24 percent for 2021; 2.41 percent for 2022; 2.43 percent for 2023; and 2.61 percent for 2024. Lands owned by federally recognized Native American tribes or members of such tribes that are located within the historical boundaries of a reservation would be exempt from such charges.

The proposed ordinance provides that the use of revenues from the system of rates and charges would implement a proposed program of work and budget. The proposed program of work and budget are part of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0424.
