METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Ordinance 19032

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing in the Council Chambers on the 10th Floor of the King County Courthouse (516 Third Avenue, Seattle, WA) on Wednesday, December 4, 2019, beginning at 9:30 AM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2019-0424 (Ordinance 19032) an ordinance relating to natural resources conservation rates and charges. The Council then adopted this Ordinance at the same meeting.

SUMMARY:

Ordinance 19032 authorizes the King County executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with the King Conservation District and imposes natural resource conservation rates and charges for the King Conservation District effective January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2024, on each parcel of real property within the King Conservation District.
