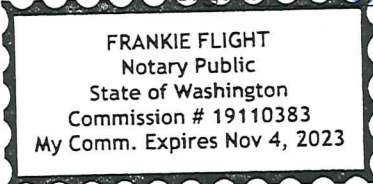

### METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL NOTICE OF ADOPTION

#### Ordinance 19119

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan King County Council (the Council) held a public hearing remotely in compliance with the Washington State Governor's Declaration 20-29 (or as amended) regarding the Open Public Meetings Act on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 beginning at 1:00 PM. The purpose of this public hearing was to consider adoption of Proposed Ordinance 2020-0032 (Ordinance 19119) an ordinance relating to an alternative housing demonstration project in North Highline and the Vashon Rural Town. The Council then adopted this Ordinance at the Tuesday, June 23, 2020 meeting.

#### SUMMARY:

Ordinance 19119 adopt an alternative housing demonstration project for 375 properties in the White Center neighborhood of North Highline and two properties in the Vashon Rural Town. The demonstration project will compare at least two alternative housing options and their accessibility for populations who unable to find suitable housing. A report by the Executive that describes and evaluates preliminary results and provides recommended changes that should be made to county processes and development regulations.
