Detailed Justification:

1) For the implementation of COVID vaccine clinics, CDC guidance, recent discussions with DOH, and previous planning efforts indicate a need to be operationally ready to stand up temporary or pop-up clinics for critical populations. Includes the purchase of at least 20 units of privacy cubes to have the capacity to stand up two small to medium size clinics and refrigeration units for vaccine storage.

2) Assemble and staff a core team to implement a COVID-19 vaccination. Positions requested include: 1 Clinical lead (PHN); 2 PPM II (1 coordinating with sites; 1 private partner engagement); 1 PPM I (healthcare provider enrollment); 1 ASA (managing meetings and document tracking). Includes \$100k to purchase supplies including bandaids, PPE, sharps containers, coolers, and other items to administer vaccine.
